VP House League

- House league satisfaction survey
 - Nearly 170 responses, with overall 85% satisfied/very satisfied
- Development stream offered at U11, U13 and U15
 - New: U11 teams could participate in tournaments
 - Teams had 14 full ice times assigned
- Lack of goalies continue to be a challenge
 - Provided discounts, gear
- Many success stories for past season
- New opportunities for next season

Linda Fennema and Grace Summerfield

- Challenges:
 - More teams but same amount of ice allocated by 4 sources (City of Ottawa, Sensplex, Carleton University and Beckwith)
 - U13AA moving to 1.5 hour games, KGHA negotiated to move TGRC to the 15 minute to allow for 1.5 hour slots on both rinks
 - Every competitive team qualified for wither championship day or provincials, increasing demand for ice in March
 - Found ice in different locations to accommodate
- Plans for next year
 - \circ $\,$ Same number of competitive teams as previous year $\,$

 Seek out other locations for practice ice to reduce need for Carleton U and allow for more full ice practices

- Continued transition to uploading electronic copies of Vulnerable Sector Checks (VSC) to Ramp
 - Added den moms VSC tracking this season
 - Many updates to VSCs required by volunteers
- Received all 46 teams injury logs (or confirmation of no injuries)
- Added responsibility to collect proof of insurance from all on or off ice development resources we endorse
- For next season in early discussion with vendor on concussion tracking software
